**Carl Pope was the executive director of Sierra Club for 21 years. In 2006, along with labor leader Leo Gerard, he formed the Blue/Green Alliance, which focuses on interrelated issues that both organizations feel are important, including a clean environment, better jobs, and a safer world. Mr. Pope served as the Political Director of Zero Population Growth from 1970 to 1973.**

**Mr. Pope has a distinguished record of environmental activism and leadership. He was the Executive Director of the California League of Conservation Voters, Director at Entech Solar, served on the Boards of Public Interest Economics, Inc., and Zero Population Growth. and was a Member of Board of Advisors at GridPoint, Inc. Presently he serves on the Boards of the California League of Conservation Voters, Public Voice, National Clean Air Coalition and California Common Cause. He spent two years as a Volunteer with Peace Corps in Barhi, Bihar, India, where he helped communities and families address the human and environmental impacts of overpopulation.**
