Walt Musial is a principal engineer and leads the offshore wind research platform at National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL), where he has worked for 31 years.

In 2003, Walt initiated the offshore wind energy research program, which focuses on a range of industry needs and critical technology challenges. He also developed and ran NREL's full-scale blade and drivetrain testing facilities for 15 years.

Before joining NREL, Walt worked as a test engineer in the commercial wind energy industry in California. He has authored more than 100 publications and holds two patents.
