Alberto Bianchetti is the Regional Director of External and Customer Affairs for National Grid's Central New York Division, a 13-county region that spans from Cortland to Clinton counties and includes the Mohawk Valley. In that role he leads a team of energy utility professionals focusing on relationships with National Grid's largest customers in the region including manufacturers, healthcare facilities, educational institutions, real estate developments, municipalities, and Native American enterprises. His team is also accountable for engaging with local and state authorities during storms and emergencies, government relations, civic outreach and community giving.
